Iron Horse Bicycle Classic Race Report

Sat 5/28 - 50th Annual Durango to Silverton Road Race

Durango, Colorado

47 miles, 5,800' of climbing.

Combined field of 55+ and 65+ raced together, scored separately.

The field of 137 starters, including multiple national champions (stars and stripes sleeves) and world champions (rainbow sleeves), stayed 6-8 across the entire road for the first 12 mostly flat miles. It was imperative to be close to the front as we approached the start of the climbing. With 136 of my closest friends sharing that same goal, the constant fighting for position made for a nervous, skittish peloton.

Once the road tilted up, the separation was quick as riders were quickly spit out the back. I was successful in making the front group of 10-12 riders as we quickly separated from the peloton. The remaining 35 miles consisted of three long, steady climbs (5-12%) followed by steep, technical descents. Once I gained separation from the other riders in my category, I was able to maintain a steady tempo to the finish line.

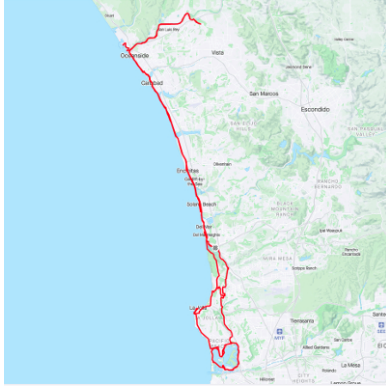

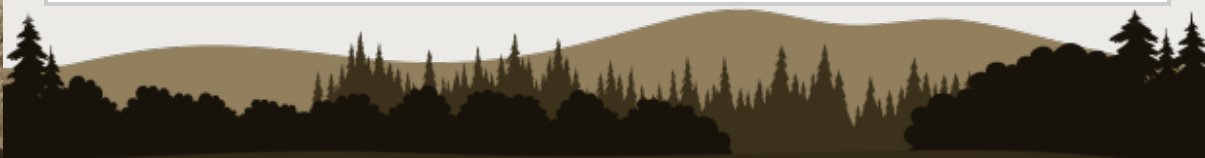
