Other than Saturday Ride Choices - Compiled by Michael Pelkey

So often we are asked, "does SDBC do any other rides besides Saturday?" Officially, no, but riders getting together for the rides shown below have the potential to draw more folks to SDBC, and will encourage others to check in with each other and get out and ride more. \* Contact Michael at 858-997-4893 with additional ride ideas.

**Sunday:** John K hikes either Torrey Pines (6mi-750'-2hrs) or Dbl Peak in San Marcos (5-7.5mi 1200-2400'-2-3hrs) 707-755-0128

**Monday or Tuesday, sometimes Friday:** SDBC members Michael N, Victor V, Ron G, and Michael P ride from Plaza Bonita in Chula Vista, near start of the bike path. We leave at 9:00, heading west, then down the coast, and up the Silver Strand into Coronado, a couple of times a week at 40 miles round trip. We hook up with other Chula Vista riders that we know and sometimes have 8-10 riders, a pushing D1-C pace with a coffee stop at Coronado Coffee Co. at the ferry landing before heading back. **Mon/Wed or Tue/Thu:** Carmel Valley Loop - SDBC members Jordan, Brice, and some others do a spirited 20-30 mile D1 pace ride leaving from 3804 Valley Ctr Dr (just W. of Carmel Creek Rd), going east around Black Mountain and returning via the 56 BP, leaving at 4:00 pm. Routes and times may vary based on group interest. Contact: Jordan Becker 858-603-6499.

**Tuesday:** The Cool Riders Ride - SDBC members Ed Leonard, Niven Howlett, and some others do a D1-C paced coastal ride from Sorrento Valley Rd Park & Ride up to the roundabout just past McGee Park in Carlsbad with a coffee stop in Solana Beach on the way back, occasionally adding an additional 9 mile loop. 47.5 miles. Leaves at 9:00. Contact Ed or Niven at SDBC Sat Ride or just show up.

Fiesta Island Paceline-Large group with warmup, then flat out! starts @ 5:30pm. You will find many of the "B" Riders attending!

**Wednesday:** The ongoing Wednesday Coffee Ride (la tour du café) - SDBC members Linda, Tom, Pete, Jerry J, Manuel, Michael P and others on a D3 pace ride from the second parking lot north of Fiesta Island and ride to SDBC sponsor

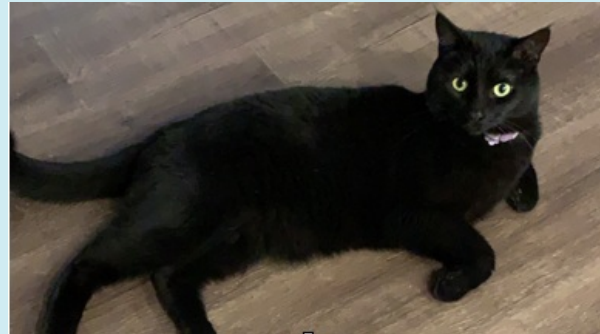
