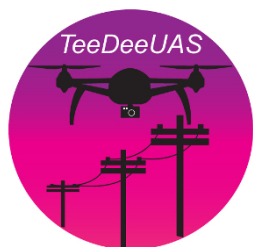

Sunday morning: Sunday morning, SDBC bike shop sponsor Switchback Velo hosts a ride that changes weekly leaving from their shop at 5699 La Jolla Blvd in Birdrock/La Jolla with a typical stop at Coffee Cycle in PB on the way back. 8:45 meetup, 9:00 roll out. We hook up with other Chula Vista riders that we know and sometimes have 8-10 riders, a pushing D1-C pace with a coffee stop at Coronado Coffee Co, at the ferry landing before heading back. 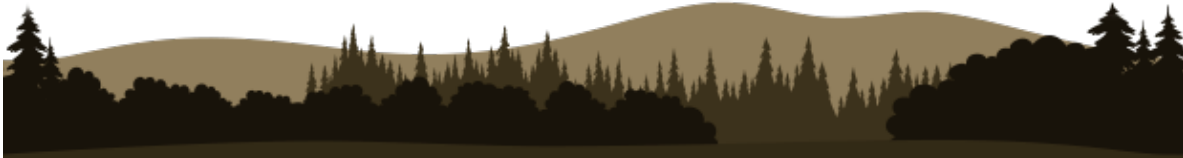
